Camp Description

Pre-Season Youth Camp - will focus on developing foot skills through fun games, age appropriate activities, and daily soccer challenges. Young players are introduced to soccer basics (*Ball Mastery- passing, receiving, dribbling, juggling, positive first touch*) as well as learning about positions, attacking principles, and defending principles.
